# **GUACAMOLE**

5 ripe avocados

½ cup sour cream

5 sprigs cilantro - chopped

½ cup red onion - chopped

1 jalapeno pepper - chopped

1/2 teaspoon cumin

1 teaspoon garlic - chopped or powder

1 teaspoon salt

½ teaspoon pepper

2 teaspoons lemon juice

Slice avocados in half, remove pit, scoop out avocado into bowl. Mash to a pulp, leaving larger chunks if desired. Add all ingredients and mix. Enjoy!!

### YOUTH ADVISORY BOARD


