OVERALL SUMMARY

Executive Director Letter

As I write this, I am currently just 8 months into my role as Executive Director of Memories for Kids. My initial goals were to increase awareness of Memories for Kids to gain more referrals for families we could serve. We were significantly impacted by the travel decline during the COVID pandemic and needed to revive our community awareness and travel experiences for creating memories. We did just that during the second half of 2023. What follows in this report will show a complete return to prior levels of memories completed, and an even stronger comeback on referrals.

While this is fantastic news, this also means that our fundraising efforts will become even more important as we prepare to meet the demands and opportunities of increased awareness and referrals. We have never turned away a family memory for lack of funds. We executed several events in 2023 to help fund our mission:

- Trivia Night
- Cinco de Mayo Day of Celebration and Giving
- Topgolf for a Top Cause
- Tribute Campaign

Throughout 2023, we were able to create 26 memories for children with a parent facing stage IV cancer. Fourteen families were able to take a break from cancer and create travel experience memories. Children of twelve families received special keepsake items, such as necklaces or keyrings with their parent's fingerprint and signature engraved. I am proud of the impact our organization has had, and look forward to continued growth, thanks to the support of many businesses and individuals.

Many thanks to the Governing Board for their continued support and direction. I would also like to thank the Guild Board, who continues to be the largest fundraising support for Memories for Kids. Both are crucial to the success of the organization. I would also like to express gratitude for the Youth Advisory Board and College Advisory Board, who work to bring awareness and fundraise amongst the young adult population in the community.


MAKING A DIFFERENCE




